Minutes for Council of Department Heads Meeting:

26 March 2019.

- 1. Provost Smith thanked departments for *greatly improved* schedules and maps.
- 2. Monday marks start of registration *if your wait list gets large, feel free to add extra classes.*
- 3. We need more face-to-face classes for summer.
- 4. We have 77% of last year's summer enrollment as of today.
- 5. There will be a *day-long work-shop* for deans, directors, and department chairs this summer.
- 6. *Merit pay* was approved by the legislature, and awaits approval by our governor.
- 7. On merit pay, Dr. Most asked if HR could pull all retirees or those not being retained for next time around.
- 8. Dr. Nikolova, newly crowned Head of Modern and Classical Languages, asked for advice on *approving a faculty-authored book for use in that prof's class*. Provost noted we have a committee that vets this process.
- 9. Faculty salary study is nearly complete. We need to complete the staff salary study, compare the two, and then determine financial needs.

- 10. HR asks us to keep track of retired State of Georgia employees applying for positions with VSU. Please send them an email if you have a finalist with this status.
- 11. HR asked how they could assist with better support, rubrics, meetings, etc., to assist search committees. These will mesh with 1-USG.
- 12. *Performance Management* is done by 2 April 2019. Good idea to speak with your office workers before they see the report.
- 13. Board of Regents is reconsidering how we employ parttime faculty. *It might be possible for them to teach four classes in one term*, and as long as there are no more classes, there would be no need for ACA benefits.
