Meeting Notes

- 1. Core assessment reports: Summary (Fall 2016 Fall 2019)
 - a. MATH 1113 report is missing. Ben will check for a copy of the report and forward if located.
 - b. MCL reporting structure and related course rotation discussed. Fall 2020 reporting reset for all Area C Core language courses.
- 2. Overview of answers to 1/9/2020 meeting questions
 - a. Should there be a consistent paragraph order? How do we address Core Assessment report uniformity in the future?
 - i. Follow format: method, meet/exceed expectations, improvements
 - b. Should we provide justification for why some courses are not summarized?
 - i. No need to provide justification. Courses that fall into multiple areas were summarized in the area where most students will take that course
 - c. Unclear modality: online/hybrid/face-to-face. Add a modality question?
 - i. The distinction is only on the Institutional Effectiveness Report and Plan.
 - ii. Good idea. Adding the question to the Core Assessment Forms will be considered.
 - d. Why not any literature classes in area C reports?
 - i. Director of Institutional Effectiveness will add reports (CHEM, BIOL, ENGL, MCL) to the review folder.
 - e. What about asking a question on the next Core Assessment report about whether changes were implemented from the previous report?
 - i. Good idea. Adding the question to the report will be considered.
 - f. Can the summary deadline be moved to 02/03/2020?
 - i. This date was confirmed by the Director of Institutional Effectiveness.
 - g. Will the Director of Institutional Effectiveness use the summary of core reports Excel table for SACs reporting or is it ok to not fill in each course if enough information for the summaries has been collected?
 - The Director of Institutional Effectiveness will use the table for SACs report. Each course, for which there is a report, needs to be added to the table.
 - h. Additional information
 - i. A1 and A2 narratives should be separate?

- ii. Coordinator of General Education will prepare an Introduction (set tone for what we find and discuss, process) and conclusion (focus on what VSU is doing about it) for evidence of *General Education Assessment* (p.5)
- iii. Core summary reporting will be an annual process -- beginning this fall.
