





Total Enrollment by 5 Largest Declared Majors, Fall 2014




Total Enrollment of Georgia Counties with Highest Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2014



Total Enrollment by College, Fall 2014




Total Enrollment by Residency, Fall 2014






Graduate Enrollment by College, Fall 2014








Undergraduate Enrollment by Class, Fall 2014








Undergraduate Students by 5 Largest Declared Majors, Fall 2014



First-Time Freshmen Enrollment, Fall 2010–Fall 2014





First-Time Freshmen by 5 Largest Declared Majors, Fall 2014










Number of Students Enrolled






Undergraduate Adult Learners Enrollment by College,




Undergraduate Adult Learner Students by 5 Largest Declared Majors, Fall 2014




Total Enrollment for Distance Learning, Fall 2014
