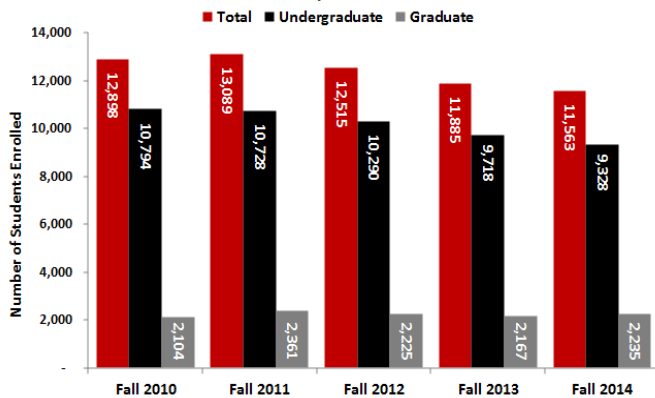

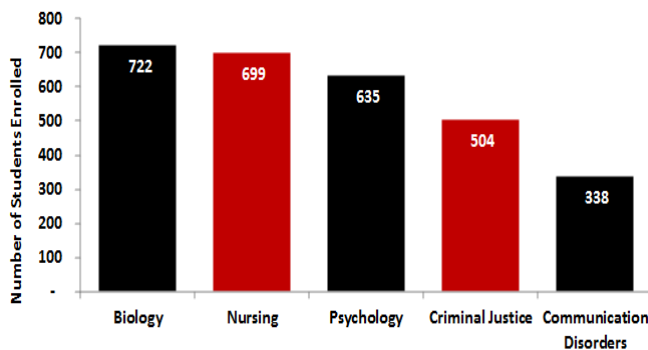
Total Enrollment, Fall 2010–Fall 2014



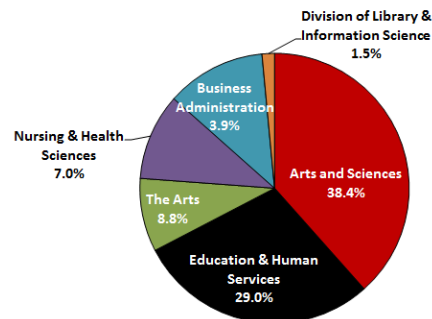

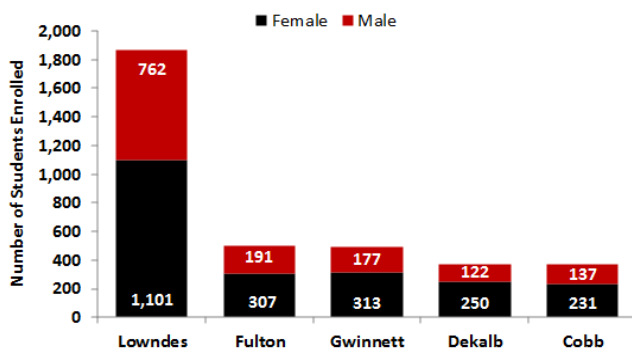


Total Enrollment by College, Fall 2014

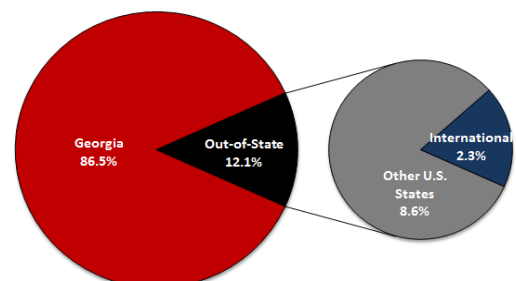

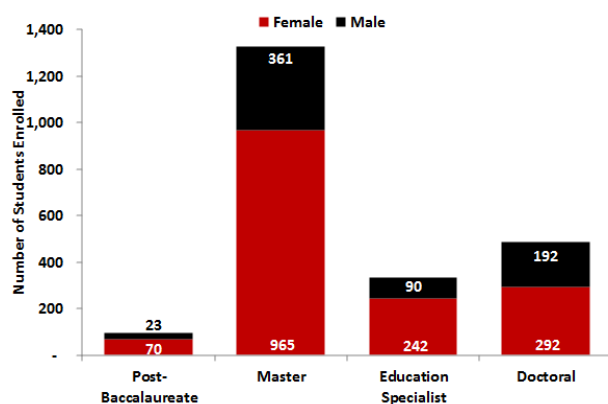
Total Enrollment of Georgia Counties with Highest Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2014



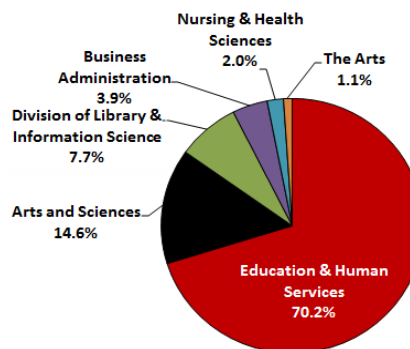
Total Enrollment by Residency, Fall 2014



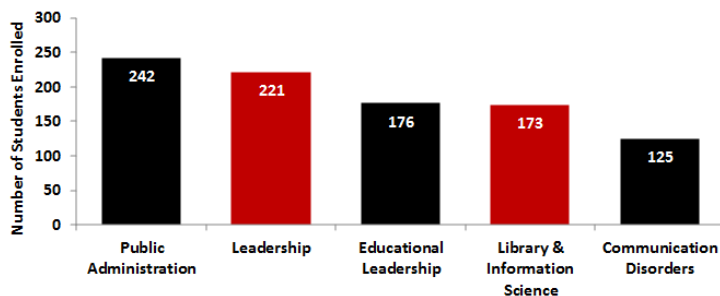
Graduate Enrollment by Classification and Gender, Fall 2014



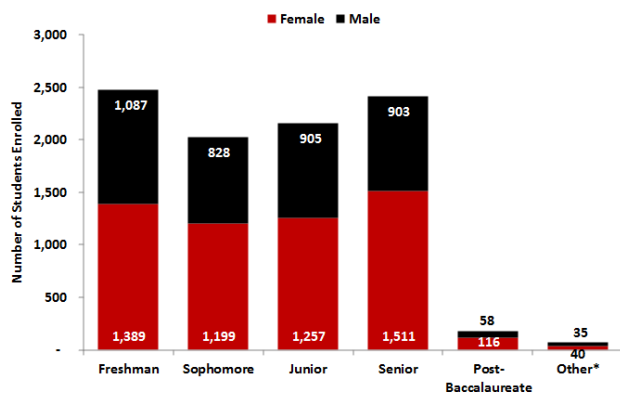
Graduate Enrollment by College, Fall 2014



Graduate Students by 5 Largest Declared Majors, Fall 2014

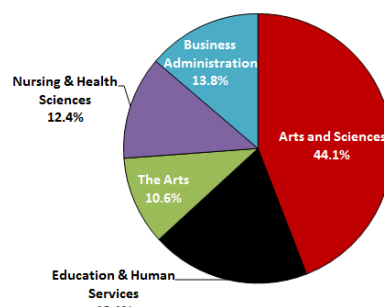


Undergraduate Enrollment by Class, Fall 2014



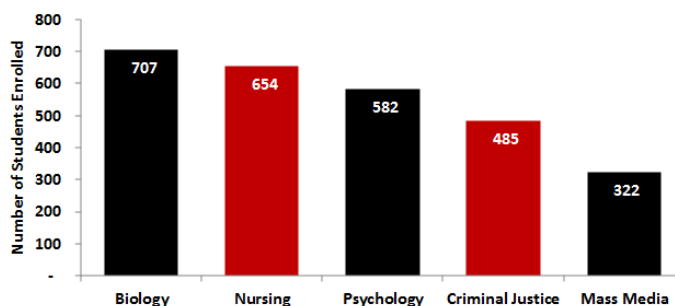

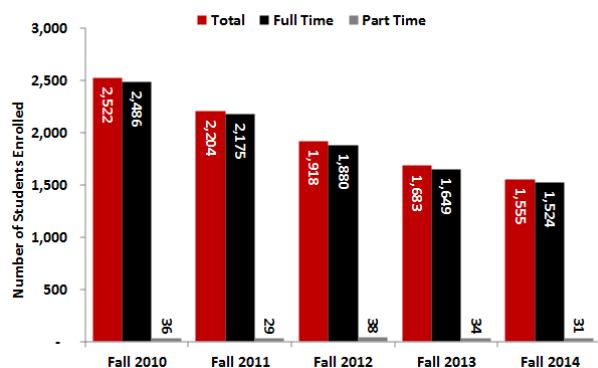

Undergraduate Students by 5 Largest Declared Majors, Fall 2014



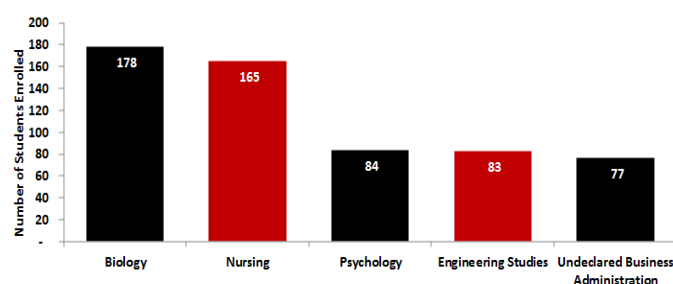
First-Time Freshmen Enrollment, Fall 2010–Fall 2014



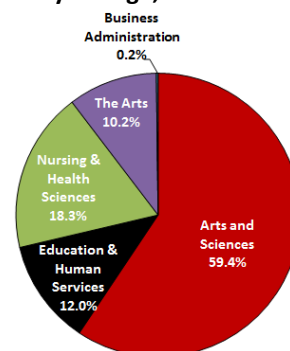

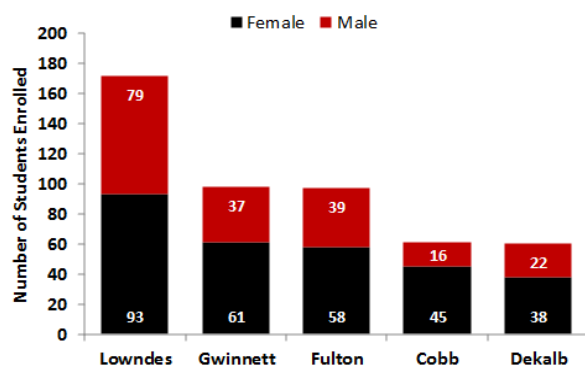


First-Time Freshmen Enrollment by College, Fall 2014

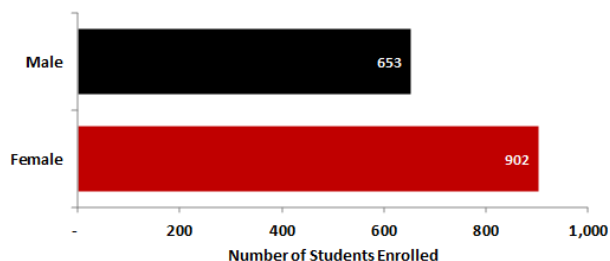

First-Time Freshmen Enrollment of Georgia Counties with Highest Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2014

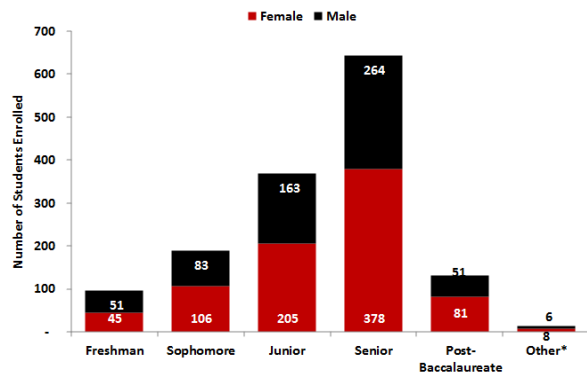
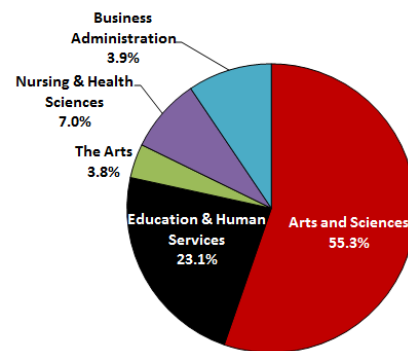
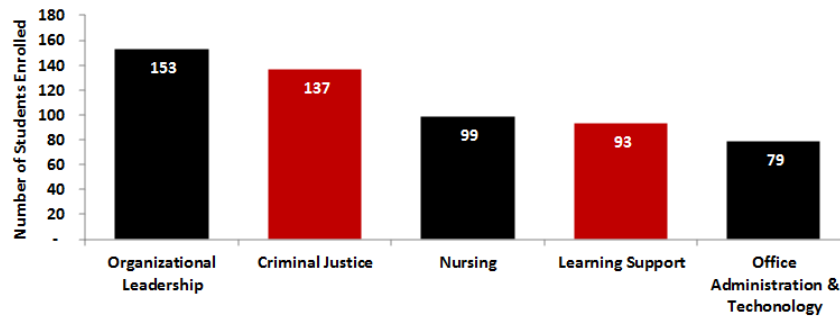
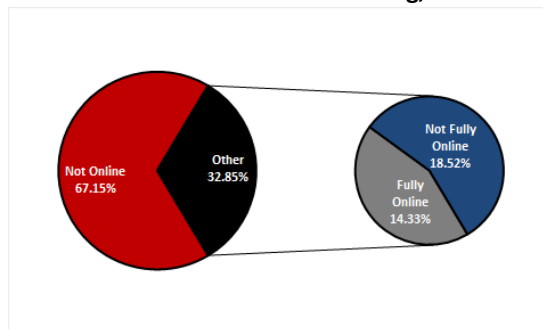
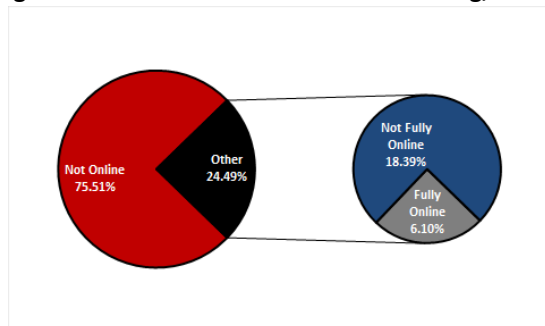


First-Time Freshmen Enrollment by Gender, Fall 2014
