Partners for Campus Excellence is proud to introduce an exciting new employee recognition program, I Caught You Caring.

- This program reinforces our commitment to service and recognizes those employees who go out of their way to make a difference for another person.
- Any employee of the university is eligible for this recognition. This includes student employees, staff, faculty, and administrators.
- All it takes is for a person (student, parent, another staff member, etc.) to fill out an "I Caught You Caring" card and send it through campus mail to Training and Development.
- The card will be logged into a database, copy sent to a person's Personnel file and the original sent to the person's supervisor to present to the employee.
- First-time recipients will receive a lapel pin.
- Supervisors should make every attempt to present the card in a meaningful way.

- Recognized employees will be posted on the I Caught You Caring website. Monthly emails will be sent announcing these individuals.
- Cards will be located throughout the campus in high traffic areas.
- Departments will be asked to help identify these locations, and select one of three card container options.
- The Council on Staff Affairs is assisting in the implementation of this program.
