

### INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE EQUIVALENTS AT VALDOSTA STATE UNIVERSITY

Valdosta State University recognizes the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program (IB). College credit will be awarded for exam scores completed at the **higher-level** as shown in the chart below. Standard level exam scores of 5 or higher will be considered for college credit for **IB diploma completers** only. The most frequently received HL exams are listed below. To receive credit, students need to request that official IB examination results be sent directly to the Admissions Office. We are authorized by the Board of Regents to accept a maximum of 24 semester hours of IB credit.
