Founded in 1906 as South Georgia State Normal College; opened to "young ladies" on Jan. 2, 1913, and offered two years of college work; 1922 name changed to Georgia State Woman's College at Valdosta; went coeducational in 1950 and changed name to Valdosta State College; in 1993 the college was elevated to Regional University status and became Valdosta State University.

Valdosta/Lowndes County

- Valdosta, the county seat of Lowndes County, is Georgia's 11th largest municipality, with a population of approximately 55,000. Lowndes County has approximately 105,000 residents.
- Valdosta, located only four hours from Orlando and Atlanta, has a mild climate.
