Reminder of Basic Supplies & Materials:

- Sketch paper, drawing supplies -Needle tool -Fettling knife
- Scraper/Metal Rib -Clay and glaze materials
- Trimming tools -Potters rib, rubber "kidney rib"
- Container for tools (a 5 quart bucket works well, Home Depot/Lowes/Wal Mart)
- Sponge (elephant ear and large rectangular sponge Home Depot/ WM)
- Plastic bags (clear 15-25 gallon generic kitchen garbage bags work well)
