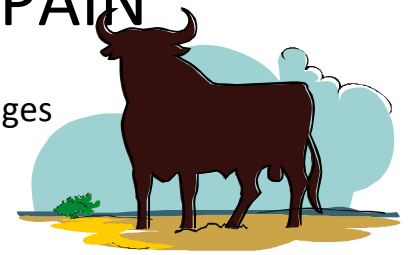




Study Abroad in Seville, SPAIN

Seville Program Costs: \$5,300 includes roundtrip ticket from Atlanta-Madrid, airport transfer in Spain, homestay, 3 full meals per day per week, laundry, internet access, a student international card, a primary health insurance policy, first weekend activities (hotel in Madrid, bus tour of Madrid, tapas restaurant, museums), AVE (bullet train) to and from Madrid-Seville, and other weekend excursions (Cordoba, Monasterio & beach), Orientation (hotel +activities+food), study trips within Seville, travel consultant, tutor, and a pass for unlimited travel on the bus system.

NOTE: The package does NOT include tuition (HOPE scholarship may waive the expense), transportation to Atlanta, books, additional meals, optional weekend travels (Granada, Malaga--South of SPAIN and MOROCCO, PORTUGAL, and Barcelona or), additional field trip expenses, or other costs beyond those listed above.
