

Feline Monitoring Program 2017 Seeking Volunteer Research Assistants!

Raven Adventures/Global Classroom is seeking volunteers for the 6th annual Feline Monitoring Program, an ongoing scientific study focusing on the documentation of puma, jaguar, ocelot, margay, and other cat species within a private biological reserve in Costa Rica. Focuses include population movements and density. Volunteers should be capable of and comfortable with hiking steep and physically demanding terrain. Responsibilities will include; set-up, maintenance and monitoring of game cameras; reviewing captured photo and video and documenting findings; placement and maintenance of track pads, as well as taking plaster casts of prints; general reserve maintenance. Aula Global Biological Reserve is closed to tourism and the general public and is available only for scientific purposes.

COST:

\$250/session, plus a \$25/session conservation fee, and includes transportation from Monteverde to Aula Global Reserve, all food and lodging within the reserve, and all technical, research, and safety equipment.
