

## Take EURO Online Courses for Political Science Credit!

The <u>EU Studies Certificate Program</u> offers a number of online courses that students can take for Political Science credit. These courses, which all bear the EURO prefix, cover a variety of topics dealing with the European Union. While taught from an interdisciplinary perspective, the courses all have a substantial policy and politics focus. Course topics include EU Law and Legal Systems, European Monetary Union, EU Environmental Policy, European Social Policy, EU Foreign Policy, and US-EU Relations.

The EURO courses are taught on GoVIEW, the University System of Georgia's platform for collaborative online programs, and students register for them on Banner just as they do for other courses. Once students have completed a EURO course, Political Science credit (for POLS 4301 – The European Union, POLS 4831 – Special Topics in EU Studies, POLS 4830 – Special Topics in Comparative Politics, or POLS 4840 – Special Topics in International Relations, depending on the course topic) can be obtained through the normal course substitution process initiated by your departmental advisor.
