- All students must be cleared by their advisor prior to registration.
- Double sections of some courses may be offered. Students may be moved from one section to the other in order to level the classes. No assurances are made that the student can select the particular instructor or section.
- Additional sections of ACED 2050 may be scheduled at Kings Bay, if determined to be necessary.
- This schedule is subject to revision due to low course enrollment or faculty reassignments. Be sure to register early to avoid unexpected problems.
