

**College of Education
Assessment Committee Meeting
Minutes of April 14, 2008**

Chair Sonya Sanderson called the meeting to order at 2:03 pm.

The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed and discussed especially pertaining to the extensive effect size discussion. J. Reffel reported that a summary sheet/table template will be provided in Excel format: one for students to use to submit their project and data, and one for the big COE report for PSC/NCATE purposes. This should help with consistency.

L. Schmertzling will share her model for the advanced candidates used by CIT & Leadership.

L. Minor and J. Reffel had no report re measuring dispositions in observable ways beyond the current survey. There was discussion about a professional behavior survey as they pertain to dispositions. Could this be part of course review? The work ethics assessment used by Val Tech may provide a good model. J. Reffel will share the ECE form in LiveText Program Accounts. Should this be used during practica and student teaching?

J. Reffel announced that grades are now OK for NCATE for assessing content knowledge.

There was a discussion about the data calendar requirement that we look at data at the end of May. Could the committee meet once the unit data is collected? The P-12 partners will be queried as to their availability. The committee decided to meet in early May to review Unit data.

The Program Coordinators data meeting was rescheduled to May 1.
