WITH MOST COURSES COMPLETELY ONLINE complete the course requirements of the program within 24 - 30 months. The dissertation process varies from student-to-student, but most can complete their dissertation in 18 months. Costs will also vary by student because we allow transfer credit for up to 2 approved courses. Based on completing 46 course hours and 9 dissertation hours, the cost of the program is *\$19,638 including standard University fees. In many cases our costs are more than half the rate of similar programs. We encourage you to compare our cost with any other institution. We think you will be pleasantly surprised to see what a great value VSU is.
