Criteria for Application

- Recipient must be an undergraduate student in the Middle Grades Education major.
- Recipient must be a rising senior student.
- Recipient must have a GPA of a 3.5 or better.
- Financial need will be a criterion considered, but this factor alone will not determine the scholarship award.
- Two departmental recommendations.

The application packet must be received no later than February 15 in the College of Education Dean's Office. If February 15 falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the application should be submitted by the Friday prior to February 15.
