Criteria for Application

- Recipient must be at least a sophomore undergraduate, certification-only, or graduate student in the Department of Adult and Career Education
- Recipient must have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher
- Financial need will be a criterion considered, but this factor alone will not determine the scholarship award.

The application packet must be received no later than March 1 in the College of Education Dean's Office. If March 1 falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the application should be submitted by the Friday prior to March 1.
