- EFC: Takes into account family size and income
- A score of 0 =The highest financial need
- The most an individual can receive for EFC = 5, 800.00 (highest need)
- An individual who has \$0 to \$5, 198 is eligible for a Pell grant. If someone has 5,1999 or higher than they do NOT qualify for a Pell grant.

Initial Need: Determined by score on EFC

Pell Grant: Award is determined by the EFC

- Eligible only at the undergraduate level
- US citizen
- Never received a bachelors before
- Notice EFC of 0 but no Pell grant than one of the above reasons must exist
- Lower EFC score more Pell award

SEOG: Determined by EFC, need to apply early, very limited
