Criteria for Application

Ш	Recipient must be pursuing a bachelor's or master's degree in Speech and Language
	Pathology at Valdosta State University.
	Recipient must have a grade point average of 2.5 or higher.
	Recipient must have completed at least 50 hours of academic work at VSU
	Financial need will be a criterion considered, but this factor alone will not determine
	the scholarship award.

The application packet must be submitted no later than March 1. If March 1 falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the application should be submitted by the Friday prior to March 1.

The application will require the following:

Career Discussion

A description of the reasons you chose to become an educator and your career goals.

Financial Need

A description of your financial need. In addition, you will include the Award Package by Aid Year. (This can be accessed through Banner by logging in, clicking Student and Financial Aid, clicking Financial Aid, and clicking My Award Information. Include AID YEAR of the current academic year.

Recommendations of Support

Two recommendations of support from VSU faculty members is required. This information will be gathered through an online survey.
