

Graduation Checklist M.Ed. School Counseling

Applying to Graduate one semester prior to completing the program:

Pass the comprehensive examination.
Must have a 3.0 GPA to graduate.
One semester prior to your expected graduation date meet with advisor to discuss graduation.
Sign Program of Study provided by advisor.
Complete graduation application.
When advisor notifies you that the Program of Study has all necessary signatures, then take signed and completed graduation application to advisor.
Advisor completes and signs the graduation application and will give you the signed Program of Study.
Pay graduation fees.
Take graduation application, one copy of the signed Program of Study, and evidence that graduation fees were paid to the Registrar.
When your copy of the graduation application is returned, check the bottom right box to make sure that all requirements were met.
Contact advisor if the application indicates that there are requirements that were not met.
