

The School Counseling Program at Valdosta State University helps graduate students develop the knowledge, skills, and dispositions required to be a professional school counselor.


- The program provides the educational and experiential experiences needed for certification as well as the knowledge and skills necessary for future employment.


Employer Survey - School Counselor Prepardness



• Site supervisors of practicum and internship students were surveyed to assess whether students demonstrate the necessary knowledge, skills, and dispositions of an effective school counselor.


• Questions range in topic from ability of the school counseling student to use data to facilitate academic success, to increasing social/emotional development and career preparedness for all students.
