Submissions will be reviewed as they arrive on a rolling basis.

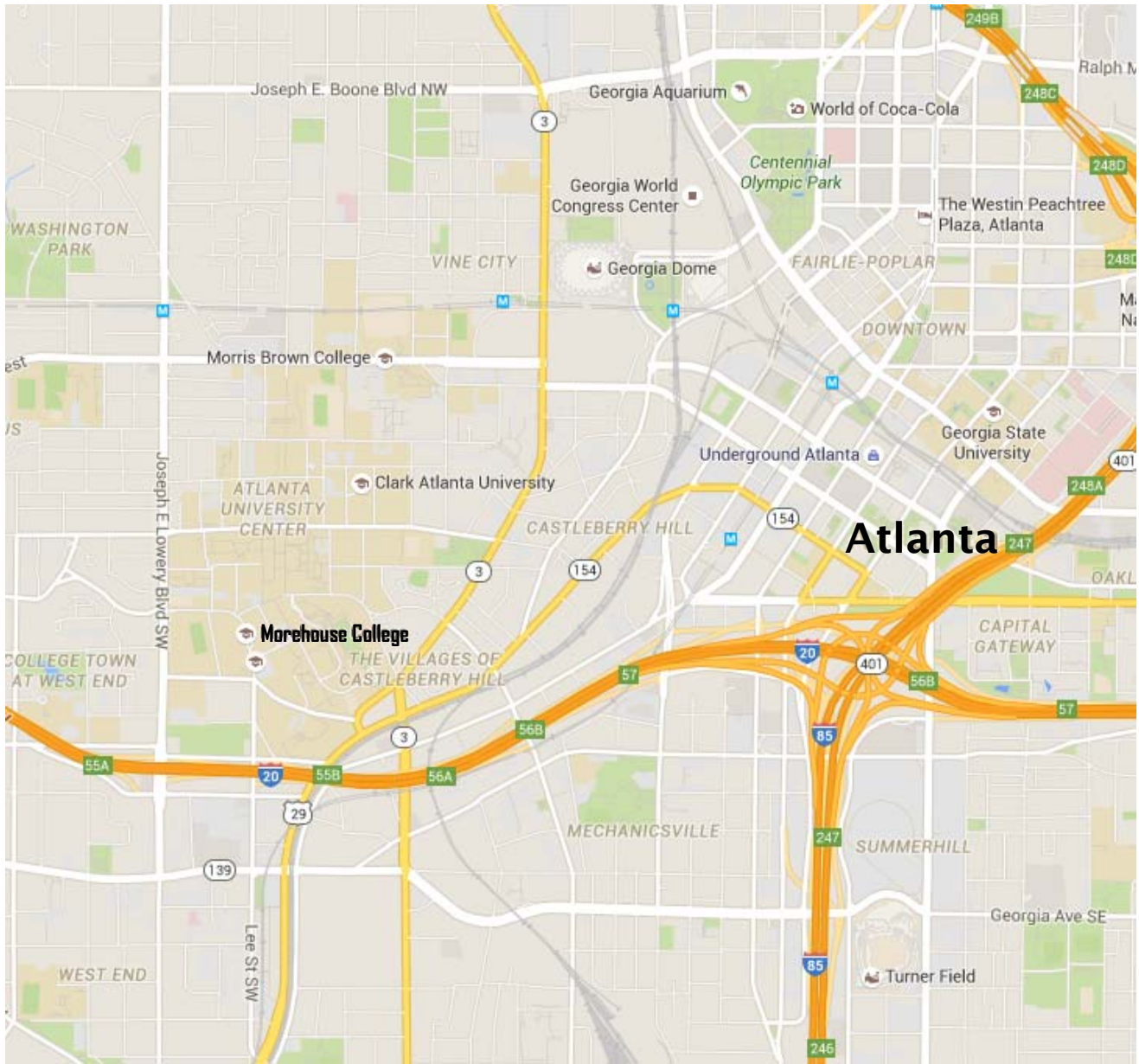
