Amanda Miliner is the 2015 Georgia Teacher of the Year and a 2006 Valdosta State University graduate. Prior to being awarded the honor of Georgia Teacher of the Year, Amanda was a fourth grade teacher from Miller Elementary in Warner Robins.

While volunteering for a Big Brother and Big Sister program during her time at Valdosta State University, she decided to change her major to Early Childhood Education. She served as Miss Georgia in 2006, but realized she needed to go back to her dreams of being an educator. Within a few weeks, she obtained a teaching position. As host teacher for a Math Early Intervention Program (EIP) class, Amanda's class has had a 100 person pass rate for the Math portion of the CRCT for several years.

As Georgia Teacher of the Year, Amanda represents Georgia teachers by speaking to the public about the teaching profession and possibly conducting workshops and programs for educators.
