HONORS NURSING PROGRAM

- Students will complete a portion of the Honors College requirements as they complete the core curriculum for nursing as stated in the Undergraduate Catalog.
- Students admitted into the upper division nursing program based on the Honors Nursing Program admissions standards will complete the remaining Honors College requirements, including the global perspectives, by enrolling in the Honors section of :
 - NURS 3101H Junior I semester
 - NURS 3214H Junior II semester
 - NURS 4102H Senior I semester
 - NURS 3080H or HONS 4990 Senior II semester (will meet nursing elective requirement)
- The assigned Nursing Advisor will advise students.

Honors Admission to Upper division Nursing

Students will be admitted to the Honors College in the freshman year based on H.S. GPA and SAT scores (and other if desired, such as recommendations or essay). Honors College students are guaranteed a seat in the upper division nursing program contingent upon an overall cumulative GPA of **3.0** or greater and a minimum Certifying Nursing GPA of **3.4** in addition to meeting all of the remaining admission criteria.
