Grammar Refresher

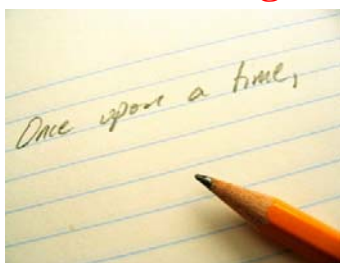
