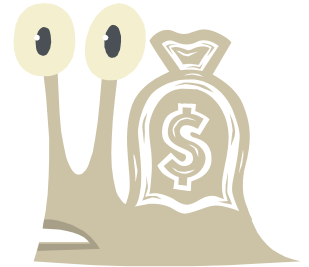


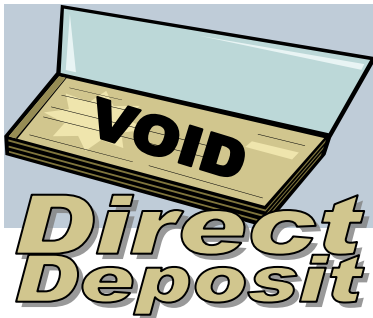
Don't Get Caught in Pay Delay!

A change in the payroll system at the state level could lead to a delay in getting paid.

Pay Delay will result for those of you who will be receiving a physical check because the checks will no longer be dispersed on campus, but instead will be mailed to your address on record with the school.

Direct Deposit Benefits

- No need to wait in line to cash your paycheck
- Funds available by 8 am each pay period
- No check cashing fees
- Can spread paycheck to multiple accounts

You will need to provide payroll with a voided check and a completed Direct Deposit enrollment form.

CashPay Benefits

- No need to wait in line to cash your paycheck
- Funds available by 9 am each pay period
- No bank account needed*
- Works like a debit card

You will need to provide payroll with a completed CashPay enrollment form.
