- A one to two-page written statement by the applicant stating:
 - o Why the applicant is interested in enrolling in the D.P.A. program.
 - The applicant's goals for advancing his or her intellectual abilities in the program.
 - How study in the program will advance their professional skills.
- A comprehensive resume should be submitted in addition to the written statement.

All documents submitted by the applicant, directly to the Graduate School, should include the applicant's full name (as it appears on the application) and the last 4-digits of the applicant's social security number. All admission requirements should be submitted to:
