

Master of Education (M.Ed.) in Instructional Technology Library Media and Technology Applications Goals Statement Instructions & Guidelines

As part of the admissions process, the Department of Curriculum Leadership & Technology requires applicants to the M.Ed. in Instructional Technology programs to submit a Goals Statement which meets the following requirements.

<u>Goals Statement</u>- is a narrative (approximately 500 words) in which you state your goal(s) for working/studying in an area of Instructional Technology (IT). Your statement should include the following information:

- Past employment and/or area of study
- Present employment and/or area of study
- Why this degree? How will this degree support your career goals?
- Why are these goals important?
- · What resources will you need to achieve your goals?
- · What challenges or obstacles will you need to overcome to achieve your goals?

Include your full name (as it appears on your Application for Graduate Admission) and the last four-digits of your social security number on the document to ensure correct matching.
