# STUDY ABROAD EUROPE 2012

5<sup>th</sup> Annual Program: Karlsruhe, Germany  
July 1–August 1, 2012



## DESCRIPTION

Participants fly from Atlanta directly to Frankfurt on Lufthansa Airlines, then by high speed train to Karlsruhe and lodging at the on-campus hostel ( [www.Jugendherberge-karlsruhe.de](http://www.Jugendherberge-karlsruhe.de) ) at the University of Applied Sciences. Upon arrival, the first couple of days involve local guided tours, a reception at City Hall with the Mayor, and short regional sightseeing excursions. For three weeks, students attend classes on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays with a field trip each Wednesday as an important component of the curriculum. A popular, though optional, 2 or 3 credit hour German Language & Culture class is available. Students select two courses ranging from 5 to 6 total credit hours. **The final five days allow for extended travel including an optional faculty-led trip to Paris.**
