

Ordinal Numbers as Enumeration (+)

For volumes that use ordinal numbers (1st, 2d, etc.) as enumeration, Marc21 provides for the placement of a plus (+) sign in front of the remaining enumeration (e.g., ed.). Voyager does not recognize this use but OCLC has implemented it.
