

## GETTING THE ELECTRONIC JOURNAL ARTICLES FULL TEXT


Even if an article isn't available full text in the database you're searching, it might be available electronically in another database or in an electronic journal. Once you have your list of article citations, then, beginning on the Odum Library [homepage](#), you can easily search to see if the library has access to the journal electronically.

- Here's a citation to a journal article from Academic Search Premier, a database hosted by the vendor EBSCO. The **journal title** is circled in red.


