

Mathematics Education Position

Applications are invited for a tenure-track position in mathematics education at the assistant professor level in the Department of Mathematics and Computer Science at Valdosta State University beginning August 1, 2012. Teaching duties include teaching mathematics courses designed for early childhood, middle grades, and secondary pre- and in-service teachers as well as lower-division service courses in mathematics. Continuing research/scholarly activities and service are expected. A strong commitment to undergraduate education, a record of excellence in teaching, and the ability to work with College of Education faculty on matters of common concern, including curriculum development, are essential. Doctorate in mathematics education or in one of the mathematical sciences is required by August 2012. Candidates must have at least 24 semester-hours of graduate level mathematics courses, with preference given to candidates with a Masters in Mathematics. Pre-college teaching and experience in using technology in mathematics instruction are preferred.

Valdosta State University is a multipurpose regional university in the University System of Georgia, with a current enrollment of approximately 13,000 students. The Department of Mathematics and Computer Science includes 34 full-time faculty and over 300 undergraduate majors. The department also serves a large number of majors in the College of Education and offers five degree programs including majors in applied mathematics and computer information systems.
