SPAN 3014 Language, Culture and Adv. Conversation.....	3hrs.
*SPAN 4500 Profession – Related Practicum or Study Abroad	3hrs.
*SPAN 4501 Research Project in Spanish for Professionals.....	3 hrs.
Total hours required for the Certificate	12-18 hrs.

*Note: Appropriate courses in the student's major field such as Business, Criminal Justice, Sociology, Social Work, Nursing, or Biology may be substituted.
