MS Thesis, 1997: *Web Page and Web Site Persistence and Change: A Longitudinal Study*. The University of Tennessee, Knoxville.

Web pages and Web sites undergo constant change. Little has been documented concerning these changes. Analysis to date suggests that Web page persistence (life, death, resurrection) is predictable, that the half life of randomly selected pages is approximately one year. Web pages located at the server-level domain are more persistent and erode at approximately 10 percent per year.

Web pages also undergo change. Two types of change have been identified: structural and content. Content change is more common. The unchanged page is rare over time. There appears to be a cyclic pattern to both content and structural change.

Ph.D. Dissertation, 1977: *Government Dominance and World Politics: Changing Canadian American Relations in Energy Trade and Foreign Ownership Policies*. Cornell University, Ithaca, NY.

The thesis examines Canadian-American energy trade and Canadian foreign investment policy in light of changes in Canadian federal and provincial policy changes following the 1973 OPEC oil shock. The findings support the hypothesis that central governments can, if they are so willing, overcome the interests of second powers, provincial rights, and strong corporate interests to further national interests. The thesis suggests inherent limits to transnational and interdependence linkages.

MA Thesis, 1973: *The Status of Unequal Treaties in International Law*. The University of Tennessee, Knoxville.

Soviet and Chinese doctrine has held that "unequal" treaties have no legal standing in international law. The thesis examines the jurisprudential roots of the theory, practices of countries under capitulations, "unequal" peace treaties, the Vienna Treaty on Treaties, as well as common law and contract law. All treaties contain "unequal" conditions that benefit one or more of the parties over others in some way. "Unequal" treaties, if entered into according to accepted practices, are valid. Treaties that are coerced are no more binding than contracts which are entered into under duress.
