- All bachelor's degrees require as a minimum 120 hours.
- A 2.00 grade point average is required for graduation. Please note that this requirement refers to the institutional GPA (all VSU coursework).
- The academic coursework of a successful candidate for degree must include 39 hours of upper division coursework (i.e. courses numbered 3000 or above).
- Thirty of the last forty hours that the student presents for the degree must be earned at VSU. Those 30 hours must include 21 hours of senior college work in the major.
- A grade of "C" or better is required in major area courses, including all science coursework required for the nursing major, and in courses used to satisfy the requirements for a minor
- No degree credit may be given for courses completed 30 years before the date of the request for evaluation of credits for graduation.
- Candidates for degrees must also have met the Georgia Legislative requirements and Regent's testing requirement. Explanation of each requirement is covered in the undergraduate catalog
