(Registration will begin on Monday, July 17th)

To register for Parents Weekend please read all of the following information and then follow the instructions.

Please note that some of the events have a limit on the number of people they can accommodate, so pre-registration is required. These events will be filled on a first come first served basis.

Parents Weekend Registration is limited to five (5) persons per family including your VSU student.

◆ General Registration:

Parents Weekend registration fee is \$25 per family which includes all of the scheduled events (unless otherwise noted), a souvenir tote bag, a keepsake family photo button, and a discount coupon for the VSU Bookstore.

If you are a current member of the Parents and Family Association you will receive a \$5.00 discount on your registration. Please let us know when you phone to register.

◆ Planetarium Show:

This exciting experience is included in your registration fee, but since each show is limited to 47 people, you must pre-register to ensure a seat. There will be two shows on Friday night, one at 8pm and at 9pm. When you register please indicate which one you would like to attend.

This event is open to all.

Pre-registration is required for this event and is limited to the first 400 people. The cost is \$10 per person. This cost does not apply to your VSU student if he/she will have any of the VSU meal plans.
