

RE: General Faculty Voting Results on VSU Statutes

I am pleased to inform you that the 2007 revised University Statutes were approved by the General Faculty with a 93.3% favorable endorsement from those who voted. Although the Statutes have received campus approval the final step will include submission to the University System of Georgia for review and approval by the Board of Regents at their March meeting.

The online election began January 24, 2007 and concluded on February 6, 2007 at 5 p.m. Five hundred and twenty-three individuals with faculty rank were eligible to vote in the election to decide if changes in the VSU Statutes should be accepted. Of those eligible, 212 or 40% voted. There were 198 votes for adoption and 14 opposed for a 93.3% favorable vote for adopting the changes.

I appreciate Mr. Chuck Hudson serving in the capacity of elections supervisor. After the voting concluded, Mr. Hudson examined the voting method, insured that all votes counted were from eligible voters and that no votes were counted more than once, and certified that the results were free from error.

Once the BOR approves the 2007 revised Statutes an electronic copy will be made available to the campus.
