Peach State Summer Theatre is preparing its 6th season in its new home, Valdosta, GA. This season's performances, produced by Valdosta State University, are in rotating repertory and are set in VSU's very own Sawyer Theatre. Peach State Summer Theatre is proud to be Valdosta's premiere professional and summer stock theatre company. PSST! is excited to announce the 2010 season—*Irving Berlin's White Christmas*, *Disney's Mulan*, and *The Secret Garden*.

Auditions for the Peach State Summer Theatre 2010 season are scheduled for Sunday, January 31, at 1:00 PM in the Fine Arts Building on the campus of Valdosta State University. For more detailed information please see attached forms for audition requirements and directions to the Valdosta State University Fine Arts Building. During the audition PSST! will see performers for PRINCIPAL, ACTOR-TECH, and ENSEMBLE contracts.

**PRINCIPAL** contract performers will perform leading roles in all three productions and will be responsible for promoting the season at various publicity performances. PRINCIPAL performers are not required to execute any technical duties with the exception of the final strikes at the end of the season. Rehearsals for PRINCIPAL performers will begin May 21 and end July 19.

**ACTOR-TECH** contract performers will perform ensemble and supporting roles in two productions and are assigned technical duties throughout the pre-production period when not in rehearsals. ACTOR-TECH performers will also help with set changeovers each night after the performance. Rehearsals for ACTOR-TECH performers will begin May 17 and end July 19.

**ENSEMBLE** contract performers will perform secondary and/or ensemble roles in two productions. ENSEMBLE performers are not required to assist in the pre-production build portion, but are required to assist with set changeovers each night after the performance. Rehearsals for ENSEMBLE performers will begin May 21 and end July 19.

All company members are provided air-conditioned housing in a university apartment-style dormitory. The university is conveniently located near shopping, fine dining, nightlife venues, a movie theatre and offers wireless internet, a pool, and gym access. The company member's salary will be paid bi-weekly and is based on the roles performed and other duties assigned throughout the season.
