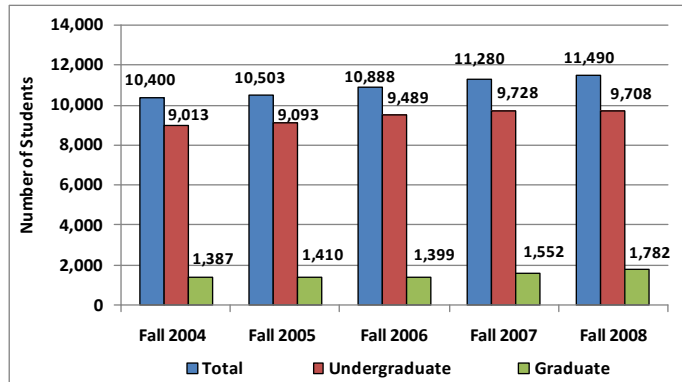

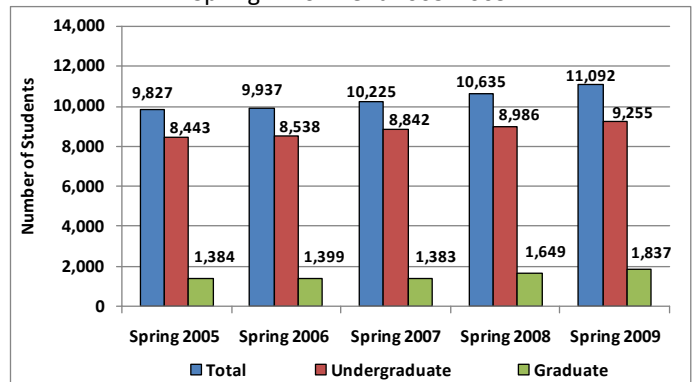
Fall 2008 Enrollment

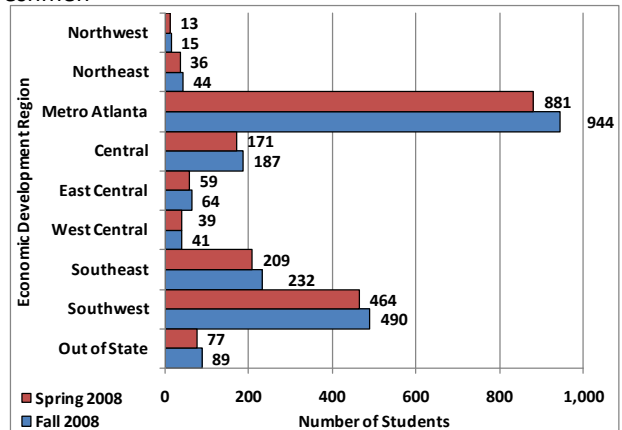

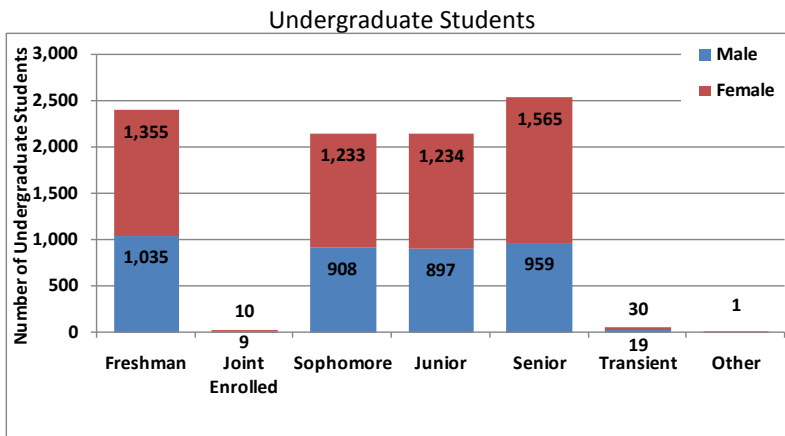

Spring 2009 Enrollment by Gender and Classification

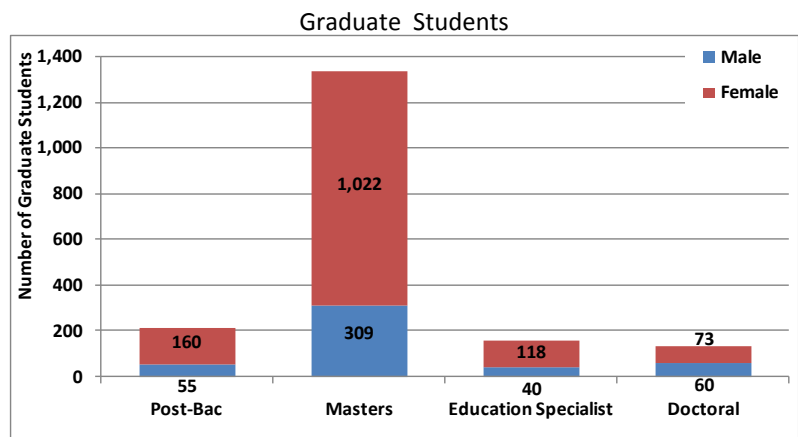


The following represents the number of students in each class level as a percentage of the total student body:

- Seniors—22.76%

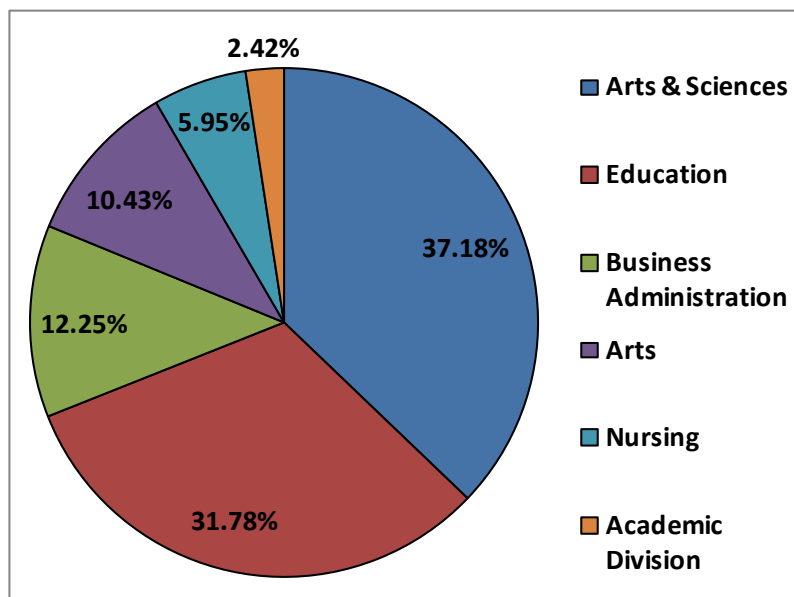
