Curriculum Changes

Final adjustments were made to the previous curricular changes. Dr. Karla Hull provided a letter outlining the delayed deactivation of the M.Ed. and the activation of the M.A.T. in Special Education to allow completion of the M.Ed. by students currently enrolled in that program.

Deactivation of the Ed.S. in Special Education will become effective January 1, 2008.

Designated SPEC prefixes were changed to the new DEAF prefix.

Catalog Change Deadline

Deadlines were discussed for inclusion of a uniform set of COE outcomes in the *Undergraduate/Graduate Catalogs*. These outcomes may not be appropriate for Deaf Education/Communication Disorders or Psychology and Counseling. The November deadline for COE submissions differs from the College of Arts February deadline. Dr. Gerber indicated that the Graduate Executive Committee would consider these catalog changes on October 29.

Data Use and Input by Program Coordinators

Data use for program improvement applies to summer, fall, and spring semesters for the 2006-2007 academic year, coincides with the PAAR schedule, and allows for discussion of program changes during the annual COE Executive Committee retreat. Review of program data calendars is important as the calendars impact each semester's reports. Fall data will likely be run November 29, 2007. Program data for 2006-2007 will be available through the LiveText Exhibit Center under F13 VISIT in anticipation of the next NCATE review.
