TRANSFER APPLICANTS

- Request all colleges and universities previous attended to send directly to the Admissions Office of Valdosta State University an official transcript of all work completed. A transcript must be sent from each college.
- 2. **Transient students** must submit a transient letter of good standing signed by the Registrar of their college, but may be required to meet transfer admissions requirements.

FRESHMAN APPLICANTS

- 1. Request your high School Counselor or principal to send an official transcript of all high school work completed to the Director of Admissions.
- Submit scores earned on the College Entrance Examination Board Scholastic Aptitude Test (CEEB-SAT), or the Assessment Battery of the American College Testing Program (ACT). If the high school cannot supply these scores, the applicant should have them sent from the College Entrance Board (SAT) Box 592, Princeton, NJ 08541-6200, or from The American College Testing Program, P. O. Box 168, Iowa City, Iowa 52243.
- 3. **Early Admission** applicants must submit, in addition to high school transcripts and SAT or ACT scores, a recommendation from the high school counselor or principal, and parent (if the applicant is under 18 years old).
