Each module comes with a description box. The description box is an excellent place to orient the students to the contents and expectations of the module. You can also include graphics, videos, and web2.0 tools to engage the student with the content before they access it.

Locate the module in which you wish to work and select "Add a description..."

This will open the description box. This looks the same for quizzes, assignments, and announcements.


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The first icon is the "Insert Stuff" button. Here, you can insert multimedia items from:


The next icon is the "Insert Image" button. You can add images from your computer, a URL, course offering files, or shared files.
