Drawing, painting, crafts...complete several projects this week to take home and decorate your room or give as gifts. Sign up for morning, afternoon, or both.

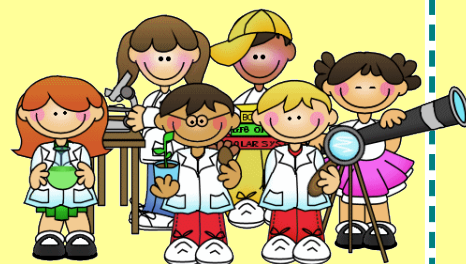
