5. Byron Brown presented the work on his subcommittee on training materials for faculty teams. The council discussed if this entire document should be handed out to the faculty teams before they start working on the project, or pieces should be

distributed t a bit at a time so as not to overwhelm the teams. The council decided it might be better to break the document into steps.

The council further discussed creating worksheets from the document to use as guides. The worksheets would set up steps that the teams need to make and set up due dates for each step to be completed by. Examples of the completed steps could be put on the website. Workshops would be set up by the GEC for guidance throughout the semester.

Worksheets would also provide documentation of the assessment process that could be stored and used for the SACS report.

- James LaPlant and John Gaston will begin recruiting faculty members for the Phase Two project. Once enough faculty have accepted (about three people on each team, minimum of three sections of each chosen course), Sheri Gravett will send out formal invitations.
