Meeting Minutes September 19, 2019, 3:30 pm University Center Magnolia Room

1. Call to Order - Debbie Paine

The meeting was called to order at 3:31 p.m.

2. Reading of proxies obtained prior to the meeting; Request additional proxies for those not given from Senators in attendance – Bobbie Ticknor.

3. Approval of the minutes of the August 22, 2019 meeting of the Faculty Senate.

The meeting minutes from August 2019 were approved by the majority.

4. <u>Updates from President's Office</u>: Dr. Carvajal and/or Dr. Smith Comments from Dr. Carvajal:

- Enrollment: The final number is changing each day and will do so until the middle of the semester. Trends suggest that VSU enrollment increased by 1% this Fall. Dr. Carvajal thanked everyone for their continued hard work on recruitment and retention.
- A forum for the USG Strategic Plan is schedule for 10 a.m. on September 25, 2019. This session was previously cancelled due to the hurricane. There are four forums across the State of Georgia. Dr. Carvajal encouraged faculty to come and participate.
- Salary Classification Study: The study showed that VSU was behind on salaries by \$4.5M (previously estimated at \$4.3). The administration is working on a plan to begin the process of addressing the salary issues. The preliminary findings show staff salaries fall shorter than faculty salaries. The study and additional efforts will be discussed more fully in the October Faculty Senate and COSA meetings.
- SACS: The reaccreditation occurs every 10 years. The report is getting started this semester. The team is led by Michael Black. Dr. Carvajal urged all faculty to provide the committee whatever is needed to complete the report.
- President's Forum: There are two Presidential forums scheduled for Monday, September 23, 2019 at 4 p.m. and Tuesday, September 24, 2019 at 10 a.m. He will discuss the budget, enrollment, and answer any questions.
- Questions:
 - A senator asked if individuals will get letters about the salary study. Dr. Carvajal stated this is what he is working toward.
 - A senator asked if the \$4.5M was based on 100% or 85% of CUPA. Dr. Carvajal stated that this was based on 95% which was established internally by VSU Administration.

Comments from Dr. Smith:

- The Budget Advisory Council meeting will be held at 9 a.m. on Friday, September 20, 2019. The current budget and projections for end of year funding will be discussed. This is an open meeting and all are invited.
- A new Faculty Success Council will be created. This is similar to the Student Success Council that was previously created. Dr. Kate Warren will be the chair.
- There were no questions for Dr. Smith.

5. <u>Updates from Campus Wellness:</u> Becky Murphy

- Mrs. Murphy introduced the new Coordinator for Campus Wellness, Kyla Dickson.
- There are free fitness classes this semester. Yoga is on Monday, Zumba on Tuesday, and Body Sculpting is on Thursday.
- There is a Dine and Discover every month. September focused on getting you moving.
 October will be on eating healthy. November will highlight how to beat the blues. You can sign up for any of these events on the EOD website.
- Mrs. Murphy discussed the wellness credit.
 - All benefited employees are eligible.
 - Spouses on the benefit plan of the employee are also eligible to participate.
 - Those who are not on the benefits plan can participate to earn prizes.
 - The credit runs from January until September 30th. If you get a flu shot before September 30th, it will count toward this credit. If you get a flu shot after this time, it will count for next year.

- Keep America Active launched on August 16th.
- The Benefits fair is on October 30, 2019. There will be flu shots, vendors, and massages at the fair.
- The chili cook-off is November 12, 2019. Those who want to attend pay \$5. Those who want to compete pay \$20. Faculty, staff, and students can register at www.valdosta.edu/chilicookoff.
- The VSU Leadership Academy is accepting applicants. You must commit to four days over this school year. Several senators commented that this was a great program and encouraged participation. The deadline to sign up is October 14, 2019. The orientation will be on October 28th and the first session on November 18th.
