- 4. <u>Updates from President's Office</u>: Dr. Carvajal

We are continually focusing on enrollment by recruiting new students and retaining current students. The number of applicants and accepted students is up 20% in comparison to the same time last year. For the first time in many years, junior enrollment has increased. The enrollment of freshmen and sophomore students has increased steadily over the years. The compensation study is going well. Preliminary faculty data has been presented and the study for staff will be completed before the spring semester. The outcomes of the study are data driven and any decisions made about salary will be based on the data from the compensation study. When decisions are made for Fall 2019, a phase in plan over several years could occur depending on available dollars. It will not be across the board raises for everyone. A proposal for \$18 million has been made to design and build performing arts center and requires 3 years of funding. The governor has not recommended the acceptance of proposal. Governor Kemp is following previous governors' precedent and not recommending any design projects in his first year. This is typical to allow new governors' team to explore and visit schools within the system and determine the needs across all schools within the system. The proposal will be resubmitted. The governor has recommended a 2% increase in pay based on merit.

- Q. Senate expressed concern about the goal of mean salary going from 85% to 87% of CUPA mean. Why not have actual CUPA mean as the goal?
- A. The goal is not 87% of CUPA. The goal is not to get individuals to a minimum point but rather an average point.
- Q. Will we find out where each individual falls on the scale?
- A. Yes, Carl Vinson will share that data with us.
- Q. Is there anyone advocating for faculty salaries?
- A. Absolutely. The chancellor speaks about it a lot. The presidents also speak about it a lot.
