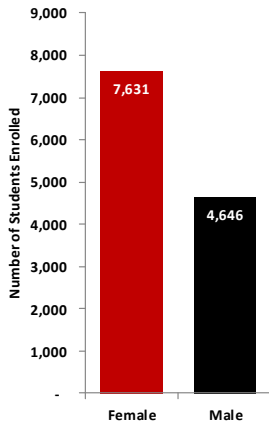

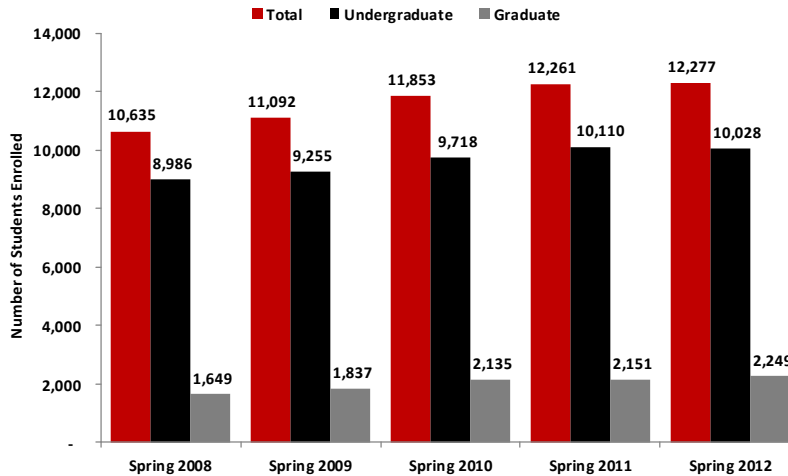

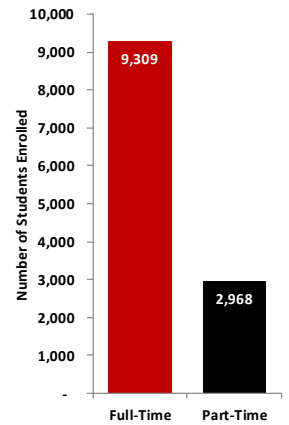
Enrollment by Gender, Spring 2012

Enrollment by Time Status, Spring 2012



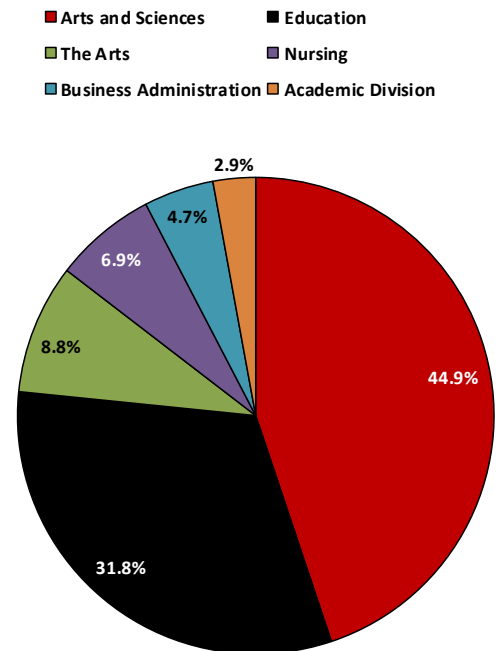

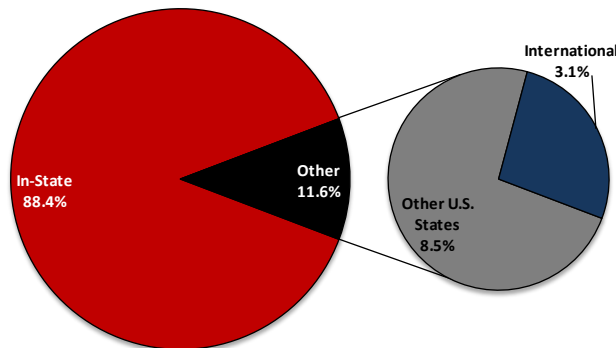
Enrollment by College, Spring 2012

Enrollment by State/Country of Origin, Spring 2012

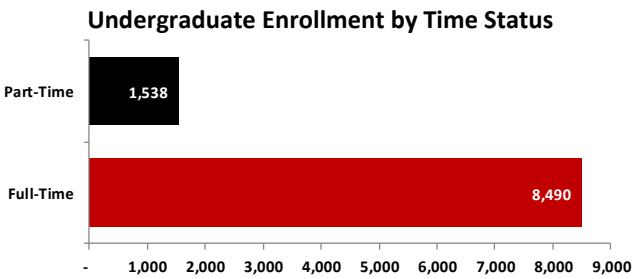
In Spring 2012, 75.8% of VSU Students are Enrolled Full-Time.



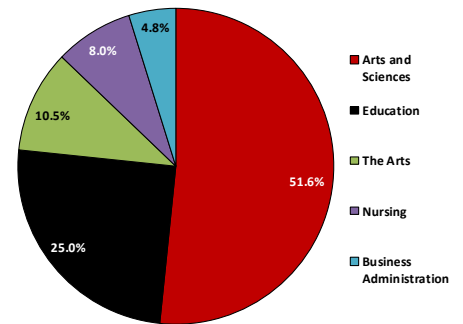

## Undergraduate Enrollment by College

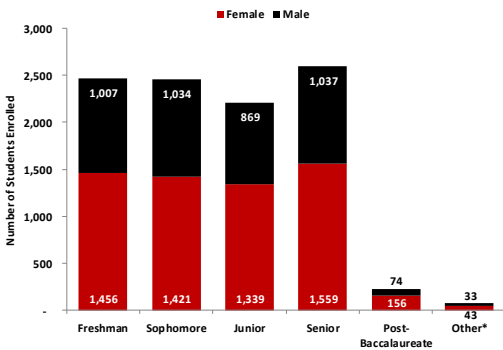


**59.6% of Undergraduate Students Enrolled in Spring 2012 are Female.**

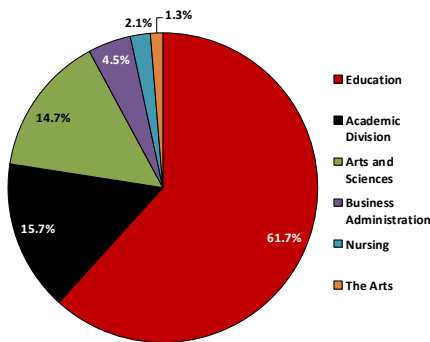

## Graduate Enrollment by College



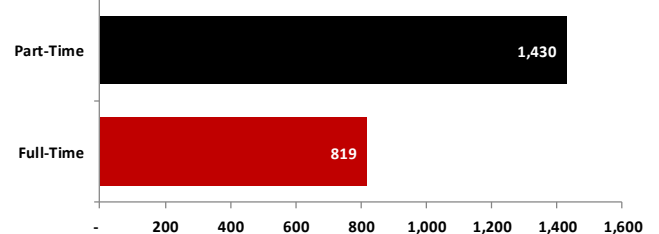

## Graduate Enrollment by Time Status



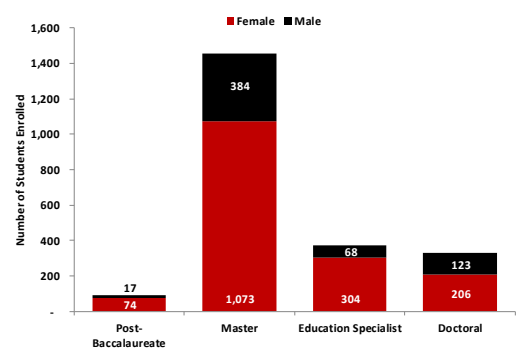
