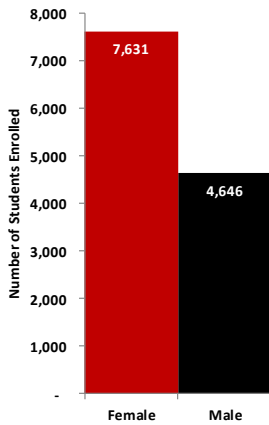


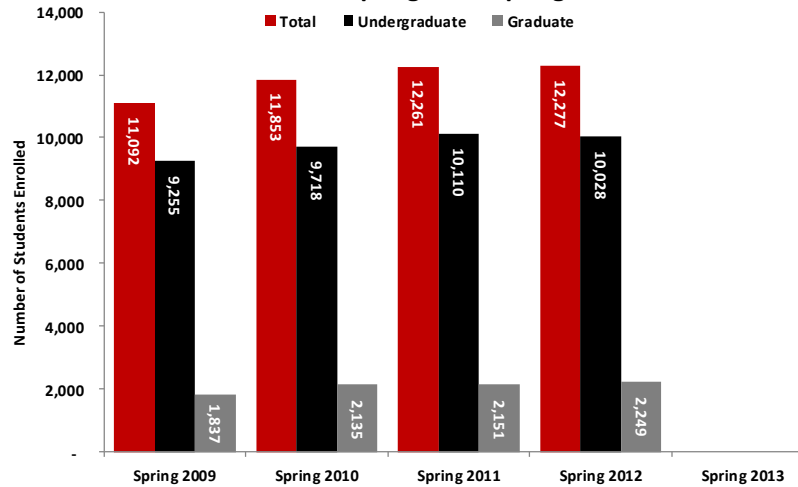

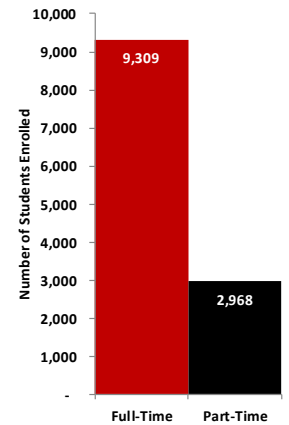
Enrollment by Gender, Spring 2013

Enrollment by Time Status, Spring 2013



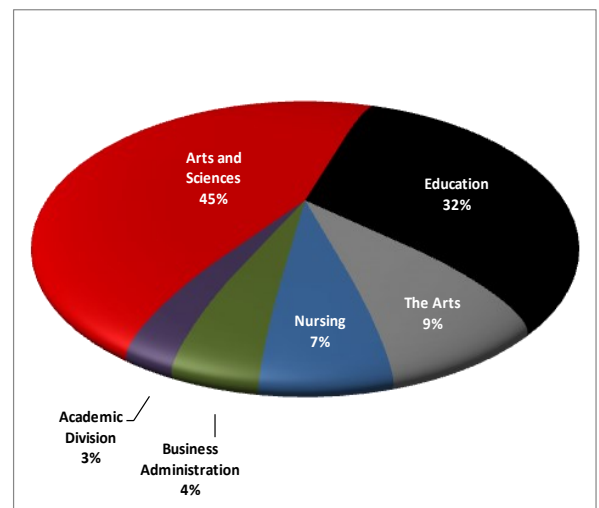

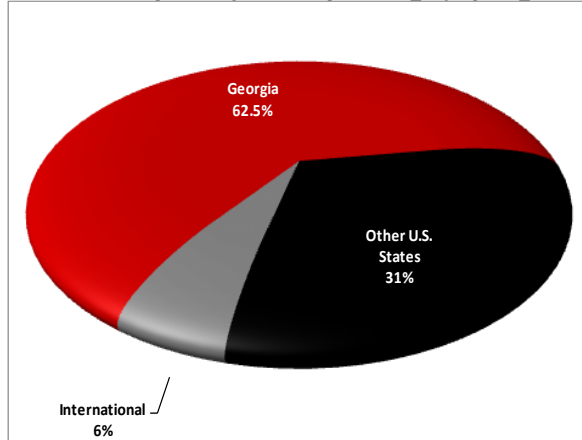
Enrollment by College, Spring 2013

Enrollment by State/Country of Origin, Spring 2013

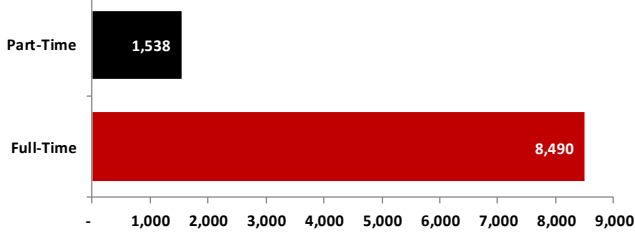


In Spring 2013, % of VSU Students are Enrolled Full-Time.

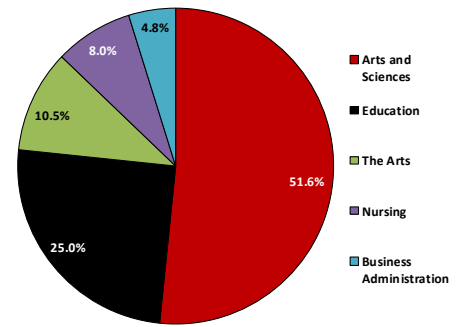

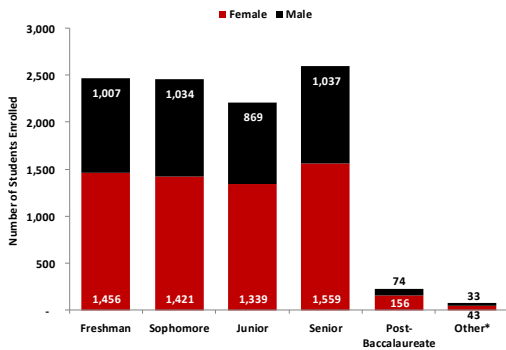
Undergraduate Enrollment by Time Status

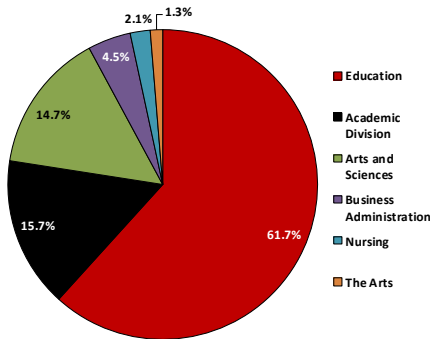

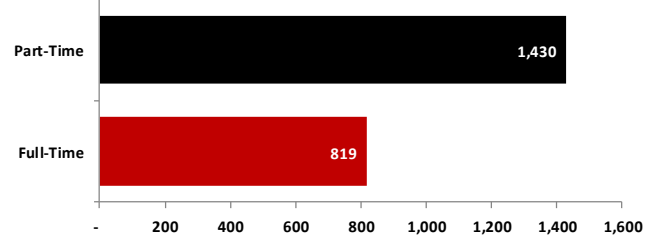
Graduate Enrollment by College

Graduate Enrollment by Time Status

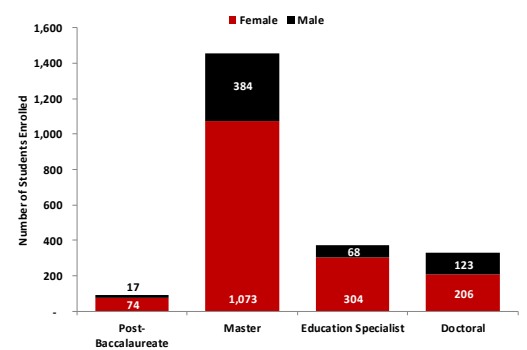
