


Total Enrollment, Fall 2019-23



Total Enrollment by 5 Largest Declared Majors, Fall 2023





Total Enrollment by College, Fall 2023





Total Enrollment by Georgia Counties with Highest Enrollment and Gender, Fall 2023




Total Enrollment by Residency, Fall 2023











Graduate Enrollment, Fall 2019-23**Graduate Enrollment by Classification and Gender, Fall 2023**




Undergraduate Adult Learners by College, Fall 2023




Undergraduate Adult Learners by 5 Largest Declared Majors, Fall 2023




Total Enrollment for Distance Learning, Fall 2023


