


Total Enrollment, Fall 2021-25





Total Enrollment by 5 Largest Declared Majors, Fall 2025




Total Enrollment by College, Fall 2025





Total Enrollment by Georgia Counties with Highest Enrollment and Gender, Fall 2025





Total Enrollment by Residency, Fall 2025










Graduate Enrollment, Fall 2021-25**Graduate Enrollment by Classification and Gender, Fall 2025**




Undergraduate Adult Learners by College, Fall 2025




Undergraduate Adult Learners by 5 Largest Declared Majors, Fall 2025




Total Enrollment for Distance Learning, Fall 2025




Undergraduate Enrollment for Distance Learning, Fall 2025



Graduate Enrollment for Distance Learning, Fall 2025




First-Time Freshmen Enrollment, Fall 2021-25






First-Time Freshmen by 5 Largest Declared Primary Majors, Fall 2025




First-Time Freshmen Enrollment by Primary College, Fall 2025
