

MyVSU Users Guide



Valdosta State University unifies access to a number of online electronic resources through the MyVSU portal link found on the VSU web site. This guide will walk you through the steps of setting up your MyVSU account and provide an overview of the key resources you can access with it.

Using a Campus Computer to set up your MyVSU Account

1. Log in at an **appropriate location based on your role** at the university and double-click the **Apply for Computer Logon** icon on the desktop.

| Role | Location | Username | Password |

| Student | Any Computer Lab | vsulab | guest |
| Employee | Any Office Computer | vsuguest | guest |

Using your own Computer or Device to set up your MyVSU Account

- **1.** Click the **MyVSU** link on the top-right of the main VSU web page (**www.valdosta.edu**) and then click **Password Management**.
- 2. Complete the form to lookup your MyVSU account username and set your password.

Logging into the MyVSU Portal

- **1.** In a web browser, go to the main Valdosta State University website (**www.valdosta.edu**).
- **2.** Click the **MyVSU** link on the top-right corner of the page, above the search bar.
- 3. Enter your MyVSU username followed by @valdosta.edu in the username field.
- **4.** Enter the **MyVSU password** you created. You can also use the **Password Management** link to **look up your username** and **set a new password** if you have forgotten it.
- **5.** Click the **Sign In** button. A brief overview of the key resources can be found on the other side of this handout.

Key Resources Inside MyVSU Portal:



Email (Office 365) Access email, calendars, contacts, and Office web apps. Students can install Microsoft Office for free on up to 5 computers and mobile devices.



Uses MyVSU Account to Log in:

Campus Computers (Active Directory) Use this account to log onto campus computers. Files you save to the **Documents** folder will be available on any campus computer after you have logged in.



Online Classes (BlazeVIEW) Access online course content, such as syllabi, discussion boards, and assignments. 24/7 support available at 1-855-772-0423.

Registration (Banner) Register for classes and find out grades, fees, and schedules.
